Removing Stains



When you have a clothing item with a stain, the stain remover works better when you give it time to do its thing! Don't spray right before tossing the item in the washer, because the longer you let it sit on a stain, the better it is going to work

In fact, it is recommended to keep your stain remover spray by the hamper so that you can hit the stains before tossing items in. This gives the solution a chance to really sink in until laundry day.

For oily stains, rub a drop of dish soap into the spot and let it sit. Check the garment under different lighting once it is out of the washer, and if the stain remains, retreat and rewash.


